February and March included speaking engagements, study time, and extensive preparation for upcoming trips to Uganda, Zambia and Timor. Opportunities to preach at *New Life Presbyterian Church* and teach at *Bethel Grove* were very fulfilling. Also, I visited *Tabernacle Baptist Church* to share the "Partnership" ministry in order to give the church a glimpse of the upcoming Africa trip, which I will share with their pastor

Mike Paris (see page 2).

Over the March 12-13 weekend, I visited West Congregational Church in Peabody, MA. This supporting church is where Joyce and I started in ministry 38 years ago. Spending time with Pastor Ralph Wetherington, my mentor and dear friend, was especially meaningful. Ralph's impact on Joyce and me runs deep. Our love for



Christ, his Word, and a vision for biblical ministry were shaped through Ralph's teaching, preaching and friendship. In August, Ralph retires after 38 years at West, so the visit was a great reunion. We are privileged to be part of West Church's mission family.

Keep Praying for 2016 Ministry Initiatives

In the 2015 Year End Reflections document, I presented four initiatives that offer ministry direction for 2016. Below is an update and prayer requests for your consideration and prayer support.

Resource Development —In 2016, our goal is to publish Pastor Andrew Mwenge's discipleship material, as well as develop an *Emerging Leader's Study Guide on 2 Timothy* and a *Christ in the Old Testament Study Guide*. **Pray that we are able to complete these resources and find a good printer to publish them.**

Masaka Emerging Leaders Focus — Last fall, Masaka leaders affirmed the importance of training emerging leaders. Two Emerging Leaders Seminars are planned for April and August. Pray for the 40 + emerging leaders who are mentored so that a new generation of men and women can lead Christ's people in this area of Uganda.

Exploring A Timor Partnership — Last May, I traveled to Indonesia and saw the work of Ben and Emma Grimes in Timor. This Navigator couple is developing Church Leaders through Bible reading and study groups. Give thanks that plans are established for a trip to Timor in May, where I will participate in several Pastoral Training sessions as well as teach a course at a Theological School in Kupang. Pray for the finalizing of the details and for the preparation of the teaching material to be completed before the April 10th trip to Africa.

Taking Seminary Students Along — Informal conversations have begun, with two US Seminaries, to consider the idea of identifying a student to travel with me on trips. This concept ties nicely into our new focus on Emerging Leaders. Please pray for this initiative, as it is still in the embryonic stage. Also, pray for experienced pastors, like Mike Paris (see sidebar), to serve God's people through the teaching of the Scriptures within the "Partnerships" project.

Meet Rev. Mike Paris



Last year, after sharing about a "Partnerships" trip at Ithaca's Evangelical Clergy *Group, Mike asked if he could* join me on a future trip. That question turned into reality, as Mike and I will leave Ithaca on April 10th for a 20 day ministry trip to Uganda and Zambia. We will share in teaching responsibilities and partner together in a variety of ways. Mike is the Pastor of Tabernacle Baptist Church in Ithaca, NY and has a heart for the world. This will be Mike's first international ministry Both Mike and the church where he serves are excited about this partnership venture.

Partnership Updates

More than 350 people have agreed to receive regular ministry and prayer updates on a monthly basis.
