August 2-3 -Leave Ithaca, NY at 11:45 am and arrive in Uganda at 10:20 pm.

August 5- Present a Seminar for Kampala Baptist Church Bible Study Leaders on the Poetical Books, with special emphasis on Proverbs.

August 7 -11 – Training the Trainers Project in Kampala Uganda. This brings together 20 individuals from Central Uganda, Masaka, and Oyam for development of future educators of pastors and church leaders. .

August 13 – Preach at Sunday Morning Services at Kampala Baptist Church.

August 14-15 – Reconnection time in with church leaders Masaka.

August 16 Time in Kampala to wrap-up details and look toward our December Session of the Trainer of Trainers Project.

August 17-18 – Board a 11:30 pm flight to US with arrival in Ithaca NY at 5:00 p on the 18th. (Remember a 7 hour time difference exists between Entebbe, Uganda and Ithaca, NY). We are still greatly encouraged by his words and after years of pastoral training events, *another level of training is about to begin*. We call it the "Training of Trainers Project" and it brings together participants, identified by church leaders, from three Ugandan regions to be trained as future trainers.
