Thoughts from Dave – Our visit to Uganda will wrap-up the yearly large group Maska Pastors and Church Leaders sessions which began in 2009. After ten years of biblical and leadership study, a transitional strategy is in place. This final session, held over January 14-18, will study Ephesians and thank God for his faithfulness through the years. We also will celebrate the relationships he has forged and the growth of the church in the Masaka Region.

This new 2019 strategy will build on our

January study of Ephesians with quarterly day-long regional events across the larger Masaka region. We will come alongside Ugandan leaders and mentor them as they lead the sessions highlighting discipleship, marriage and family, spiritual gifts and leadership issues. Then in January 2020, we will celebrate God's work and reevaluate "Partnerships" direct involvement with leadership training in Masaka.

In addition to the Pastor's Training, Joyce and I will engage Emerging Leaders and speak at the January session of the Training the Trainers Project. Pray for the impact of these days on the Ugandan church.

#### Financial Update

The Partnerships For Training Pastors 2019 budget is \$126,000, an increase of \$8,000 over last year's budget. Our Partnerships *Accountability Group* established a \$30,000 target for year-end giving, which exceeded regular contributions and support given on a monthly basis. The goal was reached of December 31, 2018 with the final gifts amounting to just over \$30,000. Thank you for this generous outpouring of support that allows us to begin the year on solid financial footing. We are grateful!
