Highlights from October 15th Accountability Group Meeting

Thanks for praying with us, as our meeting was a time of affirming what God is doing through "Partnerships", discussion of present ministry goals, and decisions made for 2020 and beyond. Results included:

We affirmed God's development of **strong partnerships and ministry alliances** in Indonesia, Uganda and Zambia, as well as the value of continuing to focus on biblical resource development.

Pastor Andrew Mwenge shared the impact of "Partnerships" Ugandan ministry and urged support for a **New Ugandan initiative** focusing on developing Emerging Leaders across the country.

We decided to begin a **New Peru Initiative** that seeks to come alongside the *Pacha Waray Ministry* for indigenous Quechua pastoral training near Huánuco, Peru.

We agreed to continue exploring **potential colleagues for training global pastors**, as well as consider working with seminary students on short-term trips.

We kept the **Partnerships Budget at \$126,000** for the upcoming year, highlighting the need for extra revenue to meet the 2020 budget. **A goal of \$30,000**, for additional year-end giving, was established.

We gave thanks for the many individuals and churches that support this ministry in a variety of ways, praying that the Lord will continue to lead this ministry forward.

Upcoming Trip to Zambia and Uganda – November 5-19

Zambia Visit – November 6-10 - This four day stop in Lusaka is designed to reconnect with our Choshen Farm partners, Jeremy and Bethany Colvin. Since April 2015, we have joined them twice a year to offer a look at Christ in the Old Testament. Presently, we are teaching through the New Testament. Our visit

will involve planning for 2020, prayer, as well as personal reconnection with these valued friends and partners. **Pray for our time together!**

Ugandan Training of Trainers Graduation Weekend - November 14-17 Three years ago, 18 pastors and church leaders began a comprehensive training program with the goal to train other pastors across Uganda. Our graduation celebration will be held at Kampala Baptist Church with many wives joining their husbands for sessions on marriage and ministry.
