• The single guys were drinking in the concepts of a marriage relationship and ministry calling.

• Pastor Andrew taught on financial management as well as family planning, which directly impacts financial planning.

• *Meals were provided and the fellowship around the tables crossed language and tribal barriers.* 

• Saturday included a Kampala Baptist Church (KBC) marriage event, illustrating to the trainers how to hold a marriage conference in their villages and regions.


