Session 9 - Pursuing Christ-like Leadership — A Personal Evaluation

When God calls us into leadership, he asks us to pursue all that he has for leaders in his church. He gives grace and truth found in Jesus Christ, as well as the gift of the Holy Spirit who enables us to do ministry with a whole heart. Leading God's people is not easy. As we studied several challenging areas of leadership, we were reminded of how utterly inadequate we are for the task. We fail in many ways, yet God forgives us when we ask and offers his grace to shape us into Christ-likeness.
