

Uganda - What's New in 2022? - Pastoral training is expanding to the outer edges of Uganda. This year we will take our training events into the Kapchorwa and Bukwo eastern region on the Kenyan border and the Kasese region positioned near the Democratic Republic of Congo in the west. Church leaders, in both new regions, expressed the need for focused pastoral training and emerging leader development.

Our first step into the eastern region was taken over January 12-15. Daudi Nkuggwa and Pastor Abel Segirinya (President of the Baptist Union of Uganda) journeyed to Kapchorwa and Bukwo to cultivate a vision for developing a new generation of church leaders. Often, it is difficult for older and more seasoned leaders to accept this idea because holding onto power and position becomes a priority for them. But, if churches are to move forward, discipleship and mentoring of young adults must happen.

January 24 - 27 - Buvuma Island Pastors Conference


