

As we move into the final months of the year, we want to update you on our October activities and provide prayer items for your consideration. Thanks for your continued interest in what God is calling us to do.

### **Uganda Prayer Items**

On October 28th, Pastor Johnson Magaya Muzaaya, the Associate Pastor of Kampala Baptist Church (KBC), died while Pastor Andrew was with us in the States. Johnson was a gifted man that impacted people of all ages through his pastoral care. At 62 years of age, he served as pastor at KBC for many years. Please pray for his wife Sarah, his children, and Kampala Baptist Church as they cope with the loss of Johnson and make decisions for life without him.

Ebola Outbreak in Uganda- You may have heard that Uganda is dealing with a Sudan-variant of this deadly disease. Mubende, where one of our Trainers lives, was included in a list of four shutdown districts. Some cases have crept into a Kampala trading center near where Pastor Andrew's family lives. Please pray for medical professionals as they tackle this immense challenge and our partners as they determine future training events in other Ugandan regions.

Dave's November 27- December 9 Uganda trip is postponed. On Monday, Pastor Andrew and Daudi made the call that Dave should not travel at this time due to the outbreak. With the uncertainty of testing and travel, it seemed prudent to make that decision. Our next trip to Uganda is set for January. Presently, the team feels that they are safe to travel into unaffected regions. *Prav* for the safety of our partners as they continue the teaching ministry through December.

### Accountability Group Meeting Summary

On October 24th, we held a virtual meeting to review this year's outreach and consider 2023 plans. We determined to:

- Keep our eves focused on equipping Ugandan Emerging Leaders and Pastors through 30 events in 2023.
- *Continue partnering in Peru* with Pacha Waray as it expands its training outreach among Quechua church leaders.
- Affirm Daudi Nkuggwa's work as Coordinator of Ugandan • Training projects and he will continue his role in 2023.
- Increase translation and printing of curriculum and other resources into a variety of Ugandan languages.
- Hay, Bob Jewell and John Kegarise • Establish a new 2-year Cohort Group of Trainers and produce and translate study guides for Seminars to be funded by year-end gifts.
- Increase our 2023 budget to \$147,000 from \$132,000 due to inflation and new ministry • opportunities. We gave thanks to God for all who are praying and supporting this ministry.

Year-End Gift Goal is \$15,000 - Your gifts will fund a new "Cohort Group" of Ugandan trainers from across the country, as well as assist in the translation and printing of resource material for new training areas. These two projects will add 15 -20 additional seminar leaders and much needed translated material for their Ugandan regions.
