

# 2022 Annual Report

## Something New in 2022



22 Seminars in 2022!!! The map tells the story. Seminars were held in regions across Uganda, with Kasese and Kapchorwa being two of three new areas pastoral training. Situated on the border of the DRC in the west and Kenya in the east, both regions caused us to face unique issues. Each location had 4 seminars existing pastors were called together to affirm their unity in Christ. We challenged them to embrace the need to establish emerging leaders to develop a

new generation of pastors and church leaders. To

The ISLANDS were the third new area. In January 2022, the Ugandan Team visited Buvuma Islands in Lake Victoria (near Masaka on the above map). Three additional visits offered biblical training to leaders of 12 churches. Led by Daudi Nkuggwa, Pastor Andrew, and several TOTs, it was decided to continue seminars for pastors and church leaders into 2023. These seminars hit the mark and were greatly appreciated by the participants.



### **EQUIPPING EMERGING LEADERS**

Since 2015, we have worked with regional church leaders to identify and develop a new generation of Ugandan church leaders. In 2022, Emerging Leaders seminars were held in the following regions of Uganda:

Tororo (3 seminars) Kiboga (2 seminars) Masaka (2 seminars) Oyam (2 seminars) Kampala (2 seminars)

The unique component of these seminars comes with the involvement of pastors who identified these young adults and have a growing heart for the future. In 2023 – we will move from pastoral training events in Kasese, Kapchorwa, and Bukwo to focus on emerging leader development. We also will continue seminars in the above mentioned

regions. A special thanks goes to the J. Russell Foundation for the provision of funds for this project.

## Something New in 2022

**RESOURCES FOR TRANSLATION AND PRINTING OF BIBLICAL MATERIAL** – Over the years, our team identified core issues and established eleven seminars for equipping pastors and

emerging leaders across Uganda. Along with our partners, we are committed to translate these seminars into regional Ugandan languages. In 2022, the 2 Timothy, Ephesians, and Servant Leadership for Today Part 1 and 2 seminars were translated into Swahili. Additionally, our discipleship material - Promise Books 1 & 2 - are now available in Swahili and Luganda. As we teach in various regions of Uganda, more seminars will require translation and printing into student booklets in different languages.

IN 2023 - We will prioritize this work so that a lasting legacy of training material will be available for future trainers across Uganda.

**TRAINING LEADERS AND PASTORS IN PERU** - In 2022, Partnerships for Training Pastors provided \$7,000.00 for the equipping of pastors in Peru. Connected with our partner Dr. Diana Weber of Language, Literacy and Life, the Pacha Waray Team in Huánuco reached out to many rural leaders and pastors. Felix of Pacha Waray writes:



"There is an urgent need to equip pastors and leaders with tools to guide their churches. Most of them will never have an opportunity to go to seminary or Bible institute. For that reason, we have made visits to rural communities sharing the basic doctrines and training more than 70 leaders and pastors. I ask for your prayers that the trained pastors will continue in the program and will help their churches, so that all of them can have a more complete knowledge of the Word of God and live a full life trusting in the God of the Bible."

"Yanapajcha is a town above 14,000 ft that doesn't receive radio, television, phones, nor even electricity! That means that when we go to train pastors in the area, everyone listens carefully and wants to learn. In September, we drove to Yanapajcha and met with 12 pastors to share basic Christian doctrines. They were very excited for the training, the practice sessions, and the materials. Each pastor committed to teach to their churches and communities all they had learned."

"A leader of the *Church of God in Peru* was one of the twelve attending the course. After the weekend he asked us to help him to train 20 new leaders in his denomination in another district. This happened because the Word became intelligible in their own language."

Our 2023 commitment is to provide \$7,000 for continued training events as well as translation of our *Ephesians and 2 Timothy study guides into Quechua for pastor seminars.* Please pray for Felix and Humbelina as they serve the Lord through the Pacha Waray ministry.

# Year-End Gift Update

**THANK YOU!** We are grateful for the generous support of what God is doing through our global partners. The year-end gift reached \$30,000 by January 1, doubling the \$15,000 goal set by Partnership's Accountability Group in October 2022. The year-end gift was designed to meet two important needs: 1) Development of a new COHORT GROUP in 2023 and 2) Resources for the translation and printing of biblical material into regional Ugandan languages as mentioned earlier in this report. Why develop a new trainer's group?

**DEVELOPMENT OF A COHORT GROUP IN 2023 -** The word <u>cohort</u> describes a group of people banded together for a greater purpose. In our case, this group will be prepared to serve the Lord by equipping and encouraging pastors, church leaders, and emerging leaders in their regions of Uganda.





BACKGROUND – Because equipping pastors and emerging leaders is crucial to the ongoing health of the African church, Kampala Baptist Church and Partnerships for Training Pastors developed a strategy to meet this need. Working with leaders of the Baptist Union of Uganda, a group called Training of Trainers (TOTs) was formed in 2017. Participants came from Oyam, Masaka, Uganda's Central Region, and Kampala. This group of 20 TOTs met four times a year over three years to study the Bible and become equipped to teach

others in their own regions. As a result, these trainers continue to work together to offer seminars for pastors and other church leaders.

WHY DEVELOP A NEW TRAINERS GROUP? Since 2020, leadership seminars were extended to Tororo, Kapchorwa, Kiboga, Buvuma Islands, and Kasese. With the help of church leaders in these regions, 25 additional individuals have been identified to be part of this new COHORT GROUP. Ultimately, these individuals will become regional trainers teaching God's Word in English, as well as in their tribal language.

IDENTIFYING COHORT PARTICIPANTS - Each one must be a person who loves Jesus, has a hunger for God's Word, is affirmed by regional leaders, displays exceptional character, uses spiritual gifting in church, and is able to communicate in English. They also need to take part in existing regional training seminars. The picture on the right illustrates our vision for determining who becomes a COHORT, where three selected Kapchorwa COHORTS stand between two affirming regional leaders (on left) and a TOT (on right). We are in this together!



In 2023 and 2024, the COHORT GROUP will meet four times per year with the first meeting to be held during the week of January 30 – February 3, 2023.


