Kampala was the gathering place for the COHORTS in early August. This group of young leaders come from across Uganda and were selected by regional church leaders for this two-year project. Our time together was full of interaction around the topic Keeping to the Path of Biblical Truth: A Look at Sound and False Doctrine.

COHORT is a word describing a group of people bonded together for a greater purpose.

One of the assignments during the week was to have each person write a personal statement of faith. Then, these statements could serve as starting points in the development of faith statements for local churches.

Additionally, the study material led to important observations on how to confront the abundance of false teaching that is occurring across Uganda and the world. Through skits, activities, small group interactions, and teaching on the many Scripture passages that warn about false teachers, the group left for home ready to stand firm in the gospel.
