Early November Update 2023





Thoughts from Dave

Under the Tangerine Tree - One of my memorable Ugandan moments occurred in 2014. Pastor Andrew and I traveled to the Oyam region to meet with Pastor Thomas Abach and a few members of Aber Baptist Church. In an area ravaged by war and economic insecurity, Thomas shared his vision for the discipleship of God's people. Under the tree, we prayed about forming a partnership to encourage the growth of the church in the region.

Ten years later, we report that God is at work in incredible ways.

At the end of October, Daudi and Elisha traveled to North and South Oyam to encourage leaders and observe pastoral training events. Each area held a seminar led by COHORTS and TOTs. In Oyam North, Pastor George Mike Nam (TOT), reports that 52 pastors and church leaders studied the *Epistle of Jude* in order to combat the rise of false teaching in the area. Leaders from Anglican, Pentecostal, and Baptist churches attended the two-day seminar. The final session ended with the group making a commitment to have additional equipping events in the future.





In Southern Oyam, Pastor Denis Oblia (COHORT) taught on leadership lessons learned from *Nehemiah*, Pastor Sam Oola (TOT) explored the qualities and characteristics of a godly leader, and Pastor Thomas Abach (TOT) addressed leadership temptations. These three men are committed to teach and encourage other area pastors and church leaders to pursue biblical servant leadership in their local churches. *Keep both North and South Oyam in your prayers as we move through these last months of 2023*.

Translation of Study Material in Kampala – It takes skill to craft study material in the heart language of people. Last week, gifted individuals worked on the Lugandan version of *Promises to Christ's Faithful Followers Book 1*. Sharpening the text and making it more user friendly was the goal achieved by their work.

Promise Book 1 Contents

- 1. Your New Life in Christ
- 2.Fellowship with God
- 3.God's Word
- 4. Jesus, Savior, Lord and Master
- 5. Baptism and the Lord's Supper

In 2024, COHORTS and TOTs will use the translated material to disciple groups of 5-8 people in their villages,



towns, and cities. Then, these discipleship group members will use the material to disciple others. Funds for the translation and

printing of the *Promise Books project*, as well as additional study material, have come from dear friends of this ministry. *Please pray for the translation of these materials from English to Lugandan, Langi, and Swahili, so that disciples will be equipped to live for the glory of God.*

2023 YEAR-END GIFT UPDATE – As of November 9th, we have received \$13,868.42 towards meeting the \$30,000 goal. This amount has been met through a generous gift.

2) The other essential priority is our need for \$20,000 to compensate our Ugandan workers. Daudi Nkuggwa and Elisha Tumusiime lead the on-the-ground ministry teams, with both providing 20 hours per week. Your gift will facilitate 2024 Ugandan ministry under their leadership.
