Dear Friends,

Tomorrow morning, I begin a swift 12-day journey to and from Uganda. At every turn, I want to keep my eyes open for what the Lord has done and is doing. The packed schedule provides a unique opportunity to do so. I ask for your prayers each day as I sprint from November 29 to December 11.

- Travel to Uganda takes time. The 32- hour trips are arduous, so please pray for strength and resilience to jump into ministry action on Friday, December 1st.
- Saturday (2<sup>nd</sup>), I travel to Masaka for the wedding of an emerging leader. Bashir and Faith are a wonderful couple with a heart for ministry. It is an honor to celebrate God's faithfulness in bringing them together. I was asked to preach their wedding sermon.
- Sunday (3<sup>rd</sup>), Kampala Baptist Church has a service of thanksgiving for Pastor Johnson Magaya, who went home to be with the Lord in October of 2022. Johnson was a dear friend and colleague. As is the Ugandan custom, this service will give thanks for Johnson's unique relational gifts and extensive impact on people.
- Monday – Friday (4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>), 30 COHORTS will descend upon Kampala, from across Uganda, for their fourth equipping event of the year. The theme is “The Church” and each day will be filled with sessions and interaction around this essential topic. Fred Cherotich is one of the members from Kapchorwaa. - Friday and Saturday (8<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup>) – Many year-end Ugandan team discussions and decisions for 2024 will be required.
- Sunday(10<sup>th</sup>) - Preach a sermon at Entebbe Baptist Church (10 am) – host an afternoon meal with Entebbe area pastors – fly from Entebbe at 11:55 pm, arriving back in Harrisburg 11:40 pm on the 11<sup>th</sup>. (Remember, there is an eight-hour time difference between Entebbe and Mechanicsburg)

As we move through December, it's a sprint to January 1. There is a lot of ministry ahead in 2024 and your support at year's end paves the way for next year's ministry journey.
