Our vision is to encourage and equip less-resourced pastors and church leaders through biblical teaching and development of biblical resources. Beginning in Uganda, we will assist church leaders and mission partners as they nurture pastors and develop emerging leaders to the glory of God.

Year End Gift Update

In September of 2023, our Accountability Group set an ambitious goal of \$30,000 designed to enhance two essential 2024 ministry areas through financial support.

- 1) Development, printing, and translation of seminar material into the local languages of Luganda, Swahili, Langi (\$10,000).
- 2) Compensation for Ugandan workers who are leading and coordinating the work of equipping and training pastors, emerging leaders, TOTs and COHORTS in 2024 (\$20,000).

With thanks to God, we exceeded our goal with a final gift total of \$30,563.95. We are grateful for all who contributed to make these essential areas funded for the year ahead.



Daudi's Year-End Ministry Reflection (this is an edited version of his original reflection)

At the end of 2022, we strategized and identified several objectives for 2023. Our

focus was set on developing a new training group (COHORTS), offering several pastor and wives marriage seminars, along with our existing Emerging Leaders and pastoral training programs.

Personally, I am grateful for the many opportunities I have had in coordinating travel to different Ugandan regions to teach God's Word to Emerging Leaders and Pastors. Recently, while concluding our Emerging Leaders training in Kasese, students gave very positive feedback about small group Bible study. In fact, the Kasese COHORTS promised to work on this skill to help the Emerging Leaders appreciate and utilize this model in their respective churches. We thank God for the provision of resources, as all the activities that were planned have been achieved.



Keeping You Informed

Last September, the Accountability Group approved a 9% increase for the 2024 budget due to expanded ministry initiatives with COHORTS and TOTs, increased staffing, and higher costs inside Uganda. This budget is a big stretch for us.

- 1. Workforce International and Joy to the World Grants (Dave and Joyce)
- 2. Ministry and Program Support includes Uganda (\$86,500), Peru (\$3,000), Resource Development, Travel, and Other Ministry Categories (\$28,500)
- 3. Administrative Expenses for New Horizons Foundation
